Zinio

Access the library's collection of eMagazines with Zinio for Libraries. Download eMagazines straight away, to keep as long as you want, with no limit to the number you can have.

This Zinio guide is specific to Android devices.

Before you begin

To use the Zinio for Libraries app you will need:

- A smartphone or tablet running Android OS
- Your Google Account details
- Your library card number
- An email address

What is Zinio?


Zinio provides access to full colour, interactive digital magazines. As a member of Griffith City Library you have access to the South-West Zone Digital Library's collection of close to 500 titles. The collection includes titles from Australia, the US and UK with new issues often available at the same time as the print edition. Magazines can be downloaded straight away, to keep as long as you want, with no limit to the number you can have. When using a mobile Android device you will need to use both:

- The Zinio website to browse the collection and choose your magazines
- The Zinio for Libraries app to download and read your magazines

Create a Zinio account

Start on the Home Screen of your Android device:

- Tap Internet or Google Chrome
- Type www.wrl.nsw.gov.au in the address bar
- Tap The Zinio logo
- Tap Create New Account
- Type Your library card number in the Card number text box
- Tap **Next**
- Type Your First Name, Last Name, Email address, and a Password (must be 7 characters or more and include both letters and numbers) in the corresponding text boxes
- Tap Create Account





Browse the collection

The home page displays a variety of titles which you can browse, or you can search titles a number of ways.


Search by title keyword

- Tap The Search text box in the top left corner
- Type A title word and a list of suggestions will appear beneath the word you have typed
- Tap Go on your keyboard to view all of the suggestions; or,
- Tap A title in the list to view only that title



Search by genre

- Tap The All Genres drop down box in the top right corner to view a list of genres
- Tap A genre to view titles
- Tap Next or the page numbers at the top or bottom of the screen to scroll through the pages



Checkout a magazine

When you have found a magazine that you would like:

- Tap The **Cover image** to view available issues. By default the latest issue appears at the top, back issues are listed beneath
- Tap Email me when the next issue is available if you are interested
- Tap Checkout to get the latest issue; or tap the Cover image of the back issue you would like followed by Complete checkout
- Tap Keep browsing to look for more magazines

If using a mobile device you are unable to start reading straight away. You will need to download the app.

Download Zinio for Libraries from Google Play

Start on the Home Screen of your Android device:

- Tap Play Store
- Type Zinio for Libraries in the Search Box
- Tap The **Zinio for Libraries** icon
- Tap Install
- Type Your Google Account password if prompted
- Tap Accept to the access conditions
- Wait For the app to download
- Tap **Open**




Log in to Zinio for Libraries

You are only required to log in the first time you use the Zinio for Libraries app. Once you have logged in the app will remember your details and you will not have to do it again.

- Tap Log in
- Tap Select Country, scroll through the pop-up list and tap Australia
- Tap Select State, scroll through the pop-up list and tap New South Wales
- Tap Select Library, scroll through the pop-up list and tap South-West Zone Digital Library
- Tap Username/Email and type in your email address
- Tap Password and type the same password used to create your Zinio account
- Tap Log In

The app will open to the Home Page which lists the magazines that you have checked out online.



Download a magazine

On the Zinio for Libraries Home Page magazines awaiting download are indicated by a cloud icon



To download a magazine:

The Cover image. The magazine will open and a blue download progress bar will appear at Tap the bottom of the screen. Pages will download in order so you can start reading as soon as the first pages are ready. Once downloaded your magazine will be available to read offline.

The time it takes to download a magazine depends on your internet speed and the size of the magazine. Zinio magazines are generally between 50MB and 300MB.

Read a magazine

From the Zinio for Libraries Home Page:

- Tap The **Cover image**
- Swipe The screen to turn the page
- The page to show (or hide) the **Menu options** at the top and bottom of the page Tap
- Through the Page preview list at the bottom of the screen and Scroll

Magazine title and issue

On a page to open it Tap

> Insert bookmark - will turn blue when page is bookmarked

Close magazine and return to app Home Page



Options - view visual table of contents, visit table of contents page within magazine, and view bookmarks

Bookmarks

You can insert your own bookmarks while reading:


- Tap The centre of the screen to show the **Menu options** at the top and bottom of the page
- Tap The **Bookmark** icon in the top menu bar. The icon will turn blue when a page is bookmarked


To view the bookmarks within a magazine you have open:

- Tap The centre of the screen to show the Menu options at the top and bottom of the page
- Tap The Options icon in the top right corner
- Tap Bookmarks
- Tap A page to view that page in full screen

To view all bookmarks from the Home Page:

- Tap The Bookmarks icon in the top menu bar
- Tap Either Date or Title to arrange your bookmarks
- Tap A page to view that page in full screen
