### What do you require

To use the RBdigital eMagazines you will need:

- A valid library member number
- An email address
- An internet connected Computer, Apple
  Phone /Tablet or Android Phone / Tablet
- An Apple ID or Google ID if installing the App.




### Create an RBdigital account


- Connect to the internet using your computer, phone or tablet browser.
- Go to the library's website: www.wrl.nsw.gov.au
- Navigate To eLibrary
- Click/Tap The RBdigital logo
- Click/Tap Create New Account
- Type
  Your library card number in the Card number text box
- Click/Tap Next
- Type Your **First Name**, **Last Name**, **Email address**, and a **Password** (must be 7 characters


or more and include both letters and numbers) in the corresponding text boxes

Click/Tap Create Account

Remember your email and password as you may need them to access your RBdigital account in the future.







### Using RBdigital on Apple devices (iPhone & iPad)

If you have an Apple device such as an iPhone or iPad you can install RBdigital and read eMagazines on your phone or tablet. Follow the steps below to install and use RBdigital on your Apple device.

### Step 1 - Download app (Apple)

Start on the Home Screen of your Apple device:

- Tap App Store
- Type RBdigital in the Search Box
- Tap Search
- Tap GET next to RBdigital
- Tap Install
- Type Your Apple ID password if prompted
- Wait For the app to download



### Step 2 - Log in to app (Apple)

From the Home Screen of your Apple device:

- Locate The RBdigital app and **Tap** to open
- Select **Australia** as the country
- Type Your Email address that you used when creating your RBdigital Account and Tap NEXT
- Enter Your Password and Tap NEXT.



# Step 3 - Finding Magazines (Apple)


- Tap On the THREE LINES to display the menu
- Tap **MAGAZINES** to view all available magazines
- Swipe Down and use page numbers at the top of the screen to view all titles
- Tap Filter to search by TITLE or select a GENRE




# Step 4 - Downloading, Reading & Returning Magazines (Apple)

#### **Download a Magazine**

- Tap On the cover of the magazine you want to download
- Tap Checkout to download
- Tap OK when prompted
- Tap READ if you want to start reading straight away

### Using RBdigital on Android devices

If you have an Android device such as an Samsung you can install RBdigital and read eMagazines on your phone or tablet. Follow the steps below to install and use RBdigital on your Android device.

### Step 1 - Download app (Android)

Start on the Home Screen of your Android device:

- Tap Play Store
- Type RBdigital in the Search Box
- Tap The RBdigital icon when displayed
- Tap Install
- Type Your Google Account password if prompted
- · Wait For the app to download



## Step 2 - Log in to app (Android)


From the Home Screen of your Android device:


- Locate the RBdigital app and Tap to open
- Select Australia as the country
- Type Your Email address that you used when creating your RBdigital Account and Tap NEXT
- Enter Your Password and Tap NEXT.



### Step 3 - Finding Magazines (Android)

- Tap On the THREE LINES to display the menu
- Tap MAGAZINES to view all available magazines
- Swipe down and use page numbers at the top of the screen to view all titles
- Tap Filter to search by TITLE or select a GENRE







### Step 4 - Downloading, Reading & Returning Magazines (Android)

#### Download a magazine

- Tap On the cover of the magazine you want to download
- Tap CHECK OUT to download magazine
- Tap **OK** when prompted
- Tap READ if you want to start reading straight away





#### **Finding & Reading Your Downloaded Magazines**


- Tap On the THREE LINES to display the menu

#### **To Return Magazines**

- Tap On the **THREE LINES** to display the menu

- Tap RETURN




### Using RBdigital on a PC

You can read eMagazines on your computer using RBDigital. Follow the steps below.

#### Sign in to RBdigital

- On your PC go to the library's website: www.wrl.nsw.gov.au
- Navigate to eLibrary
- Click the **RBdigital logo**
- Click Login
- Type your Email address that you used when creating your RBdigital account.
- Enter your Password



#### **Finding a New Magazines**

- Find a magazine using the **Search Bar**, **Genres** or by **Scrolling** through the titles on the screen
- Click on the cover of the magazine you want to read
- Click on Checkout to add magazine to Your Collection
- Click on Start Reading to read on your PC straight away

#### **Opening a Downloaded Magazine**

- Click on My Collection (in the top right of the screen) to see magazines you have previously checked out
- Click on the cover of the magazine you want to read

#### **Reading Downloaded Magazine**

- Use previous steps to download and open a magazine
- Use the arrows on the far Left & Right of your screen to navigate between pages

### Troubleshooting

#### What happened to Zinio?

Zinio has been rebranded as RBdigital. If you had a Zinio account your details will be the same when using RBdigital, however if using a Apple or Android device you will need to download the new RBdigital app.

#### I can't remember my login details or password for Zinio / RBdigital

Use the Forgot Password / PIN function on the RBdigital site. If this still does not work contact staff at Griffith City Library on 02 69628300

#### Do I need to return downloaded magazines?

eMagazines do not have an expiry or return date. It is however recommended that you return magazines you have finished with so that your tablet / device does not become too full.

#### Can I see old titles of magazines?

Yes it is possible to view old titles. When viewing the screen for a magazine title you can click on VIEW ALL TITLES
